AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to the following officers and enlisted men:

Technical Sergeant Gordon L. McKinney, 37 552 800, Medical Detachment, 424th Infantry, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations against the enemy from 12 December 1944 to 13 March 1945, in Belgium and Germany. Entered military service from Minnesota.
