Richard W. Andrews Sr. passed away at his Newtown home on June 6th, 2014, surrounded by his family after a brief illness. He was born in Sandy Hook on November 12, 1923 - the son of Lewis. V. Andrews Sr. and Georgie Northrop Andrews. He graduated Newtown High School in 1942. He attended college in North Carolina at Chapel Hill and served in the U.S. Army 106th Division, Canon Company, 424th Infantry Regiment.

He fought in the Battle of the Bulge and was captured by the Wehrmacht on December 16, 1944. He was transported by train to Stalag 12A Luckenwalde, Germany and was imprisoned there until May 6th, 1945.
