

Troops Arriving From Overseas

More than 26,000 American troops are scheduled to arrive at East and West Coast ports today from Europe and the Pacific, aboard 21 troop-carriers.

Eight ships are due to arrive at San Francisco with about 5400 men and another at Portland, Ore., with 1520.

Three ships with more than 11,000 troops are due at Newport News, Va., while four ships with 6600 men are due at Boston and five at New York with about 1750 troops.

Ships and units arriving:

At New York—(Aboard Eleazar Wheelock, from Antwerp) 754 miscellaneous troops, many for discharge, (Aboard Caleb Strong) 746 troops, undesignated units, (Aboard Santa Margarita, from Avonmouth) 226 miscellaneous troops, (Aboard Martin Bakke) 23 miscellaneous troops, (Aboard Atlantic Trader) five miscellaneous troops.

At Boston—(Aboard General Richardson) 5141 troops including 505th Counter-Intelligence Corps detachment of the Fifth Armored Division; Postal Detachment of 16th Armored Division; 876th, 877th, 878th, Airborne Engineer Aviation Battalions; Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron of 99th Bombardment Wing; 33rd Photo Reconnaissance Squadron; Sixth Tactical Air Command Squadron; Ninth Photo Technical Unit; 29th Tactical Control Group; 62nd Signal Aircraft Warning Detachment; high score casuals troops and miscellaneous troops, (Aboard King S. Woolsey), 747 miscellaneous troops; (Aboard Joaquin Miller) 746 miscellaneous troops, (Aboard Belgian Armit) 10 miscellaneous troops.

At Newport News—(Aboard the West Point) 7693 troops including Headquarters and Headquarters Battery of 106th Division Artillery; 589th, 590th, 591st, 592nd Field Artillery Battalions; Headquarters and Headquarters Battery of Seventh Armored Division Artillery; 38th Mobile Reconnaissance Squadron (heavy); 1761st Ordnance Supply and Maintenance Aviation Company; 1636th Ordnance Supply and Maintenance (aviation); Fourth Depot Unit Army; Third Radio Squadron (mobile); 385th Signal Service Company (aviation); Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron Tactical Air Command; 4033rd Fighter Control Squadron, and miscellaneous personnel. (Aboard Marine Raven) 2817 troops including 19th General Hospital; 352nd Signal Company; 329th Technical Command Harbor Craft Company, and miscellaneous personnel. (Aboard the Cushing) 741 troops, undesignated units.

At Portland—(Aboard the Fairland) 1520 troops, undesignated units.

At San Francisco—Eight ships, with about 5400 troops from the Pacific, are due to arrive. Included are Carrier Long Island, the Salamaua, the Admiral Hugh Rodman and the Tattnell.
