

6 Troopships, 5,635 Vets Due in NYC

NEW YORK—(U.P.)—Six troopships were scheduled to arrive in New York harbor today with 5,635 veterans aboard.

Aboard the La Crosse Victory today were 1,985 troops, including reconnaissance troops of the 106th infantry division signal company and the Second battalion, 424th regiment, 106th division.

The Frederick Victory carried 1,976, including the First battalion, 424th infantry regiment, and the Third battalion, 422nd infantry regiment, 106th division.

The Sommeldijk carried 1,573, including the Third battalion, 423rd regiment, 106th division, and 331st medical battalion, 70th infantry division, postal detachment.

The Gen. Fleischer carried 37; the Crosby Noyes, 39, and the Harry Pickersgill, 25. Troops on the latter two will go to Camp Kilmer, N. J. All others will be processed at Camp Shanks, N. Y.
