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H I S T O R Y

105TH ENGINEER COMBAT BATTALION

Under the provisions of paragraph 13, Army Regulations 345-105, the following information is submitted:

a. Original Unit:

1. Designation: 105th Engineer Regiment
2. Date of Organization: 12 September 1917.
3. Place of Organization: Camp Sevier, South Carolina
4. Authority for Organization: General Order Number 4, Headquarters 30th Infantry Division, dated 12 September 1917.
5. Source of Personnel: The regiment was formed from the First Separate Battalion of North Carolina Engineers which became the First Battalion, 105th Engineers, and the First Battalion of the First Infantry, North Carolina National Guard, became the Second Battalion, 105th Engineers.

b. Changes in Organization and Designation of Units:

On February 16, 1942, the Regiment was redesignated the 105th Engineer Battalion (Combat), pursuant to General Order No. 5, Headquarters 30th Infantry Division, dated 16 February 1942. As a result of this reorganization, three of the six line companies, A, B, and F, of the regiment formed the Second Battalion of the 175th Engineers, and companies, D, E, and C, became Companies A, B, and C, respectively of the new battalion. The strength of the 105th Engineer Battalion, 16 February 1942, was 22 officers and 434 enlisted men, plus 6 officers and 26 enlisted men in the Medical Detachment, and one Warrant Officer and 29 enlisted men in the attached band. Headquarters Company became Headquarters and Service Company of the new battalion, and the 105th band was transferred to the Reception Center, Camp Beauregard, Louisiana.

In May 1942, new Tables of Organization were received dated 1 April 1942. (T/O 5-15; 5-16; 5-17). Under the new Tables of Organization the authorized strength of the battalion changed from 18 officers and 616 enlisted men to 25 officers and 718 enlisted men (not including the Medical Detachment). This increase provided one additional officer per line company and added four officers to the battalion staff. The additions were S-2; S-3; S-4, and an assistant adjutant.

In August 1943, new tables of organization were received, dated 15 July 1943, (T/O 5-15; 5-16; 5-17). Under the new Tables of Organization the Authorized strength of the battalion changed from 25 officers and 718 enlisted men (not including the Medical Detachment), to 30 officers and 617 enlisted men. This increase of officer personnel provided for two additional 2nd Lieutenants and two Warrant Officers, Junior Grade. These additions were

## d. Stations (permanent or temporary) of unit or parts thereof:

The permanent station of the 105th Engineer Combat Battalion was Camp Atterbury, Indiana.

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History, 105th Engineer Combat Battalion (Cont'd)

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On 27 January 1944, the battalion entrained at Camp Atterbury, Indiana, for Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts, staging area. The battalion arrived at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts, staging area on 28 January 1944.

On 11 January 1944, the battalion entrained at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts, for the Boston Port of Embarkation, and arrived there shortly after 1200.

At the Boston Port of Embarkation, the battalion was regrouped into Combat Teams. Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company, were separated into two groups. Half of the personnel embarked on the SS John Erickson, and the remaining half on the SS Brazil. Company "A", and the Medical Detachment embarked on the SS John Erickson. Company "B", embarked on the SS Brazil, and Company "C" embarked on the Empress of Australia.

The convoy carrying the battalion departed Boston Port of Embarkation, 12 February 1944.

Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company, Medical Detachment, Companies "A" and "B", arrived at Liverpool, England, 22 February 1944, and Company "C" arrived at Glasgow, Scotland the same date.

On 24 February 1944, Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company, Medical Detachment, Companies "A" and "B", debarked at Liverpool, England, and arrived at Wooddale Camp, Billingshurst, England, on the 25 February 1944.

Company "C" debarked at Glasgow, Scotland, on 25 February 1944, and arrived at Wooddale Camp, Billingshurst, England, on the 26 February 1944.

On 4 April 1944, the battalion departed Wooddale Camp, Billingshurst, England, and arrived at Dropmore Camp, Slough, England, the same date.

On 9 June 1944, Companies "A", "B" and "C" departed Dropmore Camp, Slough, England, for Southampton Port of Embarkation and arrived there the same date.

On 11 June 1944, Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company and Medical Detachment departed from Dropmore Camp, Slough, England, for Portland Port of Embarkation and arrived there the same date.

On 12 June 1944, Companies "B" and "C" embarked at Southampton Port of Embarkation for France, and arrived in the Vierville Area, France, on 13 June 1944, then moved to battalion bivouac area 1 1/2 miles SE Isigny, France.

On 14 June, Company "A" embarked at Southampton Port of Embarkation, for France, and arrived in the Vierville Area, France, same date, then moved to battalion bivouac area 1 1/2 miles SE Isigny, France. Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company, and Medical Detachment embarked at Portland Port of Embarkation for France, and arrived at the Vierville Area, France,

15 June 1944, and moved to battalion bivouac area 1 1/2 miles SE Isigny, France.

On 16 June 1944, the line companies joined their respective Combat Teams.
