On 5-9 October, in Holland, destroyed enemy machine gun and forced tank to withdraw. Drove tank away from friendly lines.

Although wounded, on 28 July, in France, assisted in knocking out machine gun. Silver Star.

(3) R. D. Alexander, 36893722.

On 23 November, in Germany, as one of only four non-casualties in an attacking platoon, succeeded in accomplishing mission.

(4) Walter (NMI) Allen, 35777358.

On 19 September, in Belgium, on dangerous patrol, gained valuable information.
