

New Jersey Cavalry To Go To Jackson

Columbia, Jan. 2.—Headquarters at Fort Jackson said today that 800 officers and men of the 102nd cavalry of the New Jersey National guard would arrive at the post January 12 to 15.

The horse-mechanized cavalry will come from Newark, West Orange and Westfield, N. J. An advance detachment including all motors and trucks scheduled to arrive January 12 and the remainder of the regiment on January 15.

Arrival of the New Jersey regiment will bring to 24,100 the number of officers and men now stationed at the fort. A total of 6,000 selective service men will be sent to the fort this month for permanent station with the 30th division.

Other units are scheduled to arrive during the spring to boost the fort's manpower up to about 43,000 officers and men.
