

The War department announced today the retirement of Brigadier General Robert J. Travis, national guard of the U. S., at present serving with the 30th division at Fort Jackson, S. C. General Travis will reach the statutory retirement age of 64 on January 13.

General Travis is a distant cousin of S. E. Travis, attorney of Hattiesburg. General Travis was at Camp Shelby last summer when the 30th division trained there for two weeks.
