

SECOND BUILDING PROJECT STARTED AT FORT JACKSON

FORT JACKSON, S. C., Jan. 15. (Special)—The second phase of the \$11,000,000 construction program at the fort by the J. A. Jones construction company of Charlotte has begun with the completion of a new post headquarters building, and two additions to 30th division headquarters.

The Jones company staying ahead of the construction schedule for the past three months, has now completed the permanent camps of the 8th and 30th divisions and has built two camp areas for the 128th field artillery of Missouri and the 102nd cavalry of New Jersey, two corps units.

With all the quarters completed which are necessary to house the war strengths of all units here in training, construction has begun on additional headquarters building, more recreation centers and the "finishing touches" on camps already built.

The 30th division headquarters, one big two-story building, was found inadequate for the large number of officers and clerks and is now being expanded. Two additional buildings, almost completed, will be ready for use by Saturday, it is believed.

Thousands of gallons of paint will be put on the new buildings. shrubbery will be planted, and miles of new roads will be built.
