

## ARMY COMPLETES 'STREAMLINE' JOB ON 30TH DIVISION

**F**ORT JACKSON, S. C., Feb. 21. (AP)—Division headquarters announced today "streamlining" of the 30th infantry division into a triangular division, begun two months ago, had been completed.

The national guard unit, famous for its smash through the Hindenburg line on October 29, 1918, is composed of national guardsmen from Tennessee, Georgia and the two Carolinas, and is known as the "Old Hickory" division.

The 30th was one of four national guard divisions called into federal service in September, 1940, and at that time was a square division.
