

2,000 Tennesseans Called When 30th Mobilized

When the Thirtieth was mobilized into federal service in September, 1940, it contained the following units of the Tennessee National Guard:

115th Field Artillery, 117th Infantry, 109th Cavalry, 105th Observation Squadron, 55th Field Artillery, 191st Field Artillery and the 105th Quartermasters Regiment.

The 191st Field Artillery, with the 109th Cavalry, which was converted into the 181st Field Artillery, were separated from the 30th, however, and stationed at Camp Forrest.

Approximately 2,000 Tennessee National Guardsmen were called into service in September, 1940, when the guard was mobilized into the federal army.
