

War Workers, Officials To Visit 30th Division

Representative Columbus war workers will be among 400 Hoosier "soldiers of production" who will live the life of fighting men and observe a typical day's training with the 30th Infantry division at Camp Atterbury on Dec. 13.

Plans for the event were announced Sunday by the Atterbury public relations division. Last March a similar program was held at Atterbury when 240 war workers representing workers in plants of four Middlewestern states visited the 83rd Infantry division at Atterbury.

Maj. Gen. L. S. Hobbs, commanding general of the 30th Division, and Col. Welton M. Modisette, Atterbury post commander, will welcome the visitors to a dawn-to-dusk series of demonstrations designed to show the war plant workers why "more and more" and "better and better" equipment is urgently needed now by this nation's fighting men and Allies over the world.

117 War Plants Invited.

Invitations to the realistic demonstration have been extended by General Hobbs and Colonel Modisette, in conjunction with the Industrial Services division of the

War department, to 117 Indiana war plants, as well as Gov. Henry F. Schricker, 30 mayors and Army officials of the Second Army and Fifth Service command. The War Production board's office in Indianapolis is cooperating with Army officials in the civilian visit to a combat division in training.

Mayor Carlos S. Folger of Columbus is among the mayors who are being invited to the event, along with worker representatives from war plants in this area.

General Hobbs in his invitation to war plant representatives, expressed the purpose of the program and the hope that the workers "will take home a better understanding of the need for more and better equipment, as well as a fuller appreciation of the rigorous life and strenuous training of your soldiers."

Colonel Modisette suggested "that most delegates be appointed from the rank and file who are qualified to relate their experiences upon their return."
