**Atterbury Unit Can Repair
Everything from Watch
to Howitzer.**

Camp Atterbury, Dec. 15 (Special)—The much advertised slogan, "no job too little—no job too big," aptly explains the operations of the 730th Light Ordnance company here, specialists in repairing anything from a stop-watch to a 155 mm. howitzer or an Army ten-wheeler.

The mechanics of the automotive section of this 30th Division unit handle all of the units' heavy repair which cannot be handled in the individual outfits' motor pools.

Speedy but perfect work is the section's aim. The "quick-change" mechanics claim they can switch engines in a quarter-ton Jeep in an hour, or take the engine out of a 2½ ton truck and install a new one in 100 minutes.

The armament section repairs pistols, shoulder and heavy weapons, in addition to fixing all types of watches, compasses, observation telescopes, and delicate instruments. An average of 200 jobs daily are turned out by the small arms repairmen.
