

GRIDS TEAMS TO PLAY AT CAMP

Football Fields Set Up at
Atterbury—Other Entertain-
ment Planned.

Further entertainment and recreational plans are being made for Uncle Sam's soldiers stationed at Camp Atterbury.

Football fields are being set up in the cantonment area and schedules have been arranged for intramural games between teams in the various regiments. A tourney also may be held to determine the camp's grid champions.

Plans also are being made for a boxing tournament to be staged in the 83rd Infantry division, with the winners to represent the division in a match at Indianapolis with a team from another Army camp. Lieut. Harold Brown, special service officer, will be in charge of the boxing program.

Along less strenuous entertainment lines, Ace Brigode and his orchestra have been booked to appear at the camp on Oct. 5. The appearance was arranged by the 83rd Division, but the show will be open to all personnel at the camp. It will be staged at Theater No. 2.

Tentative plans also are being made for the Indianapolis Symphony orchestra to appear at the camp during the early part of next year.
