

Dozen Army Camp Chapels Dedicated

Camp Atterbury, Ind., Oct. 8.—(AP)—Col. Welton M. Modisette, post commander at Atterbury, yesterday received the keys to 12 chapels provided for the men of the 83rd division.

Major W. A. Arrasmith, area engineer, presented the keys during ceremonies attended by Protestants, Roman Catholics, and Jews representing all units of the post.

Two chapels, all of standard styles costing \$21,000 apiece, were dedicated by Col. Albert L. Evans, fifth service command chaplain, in his address. Four hundred persons can be accommodated in each chapel.
