

SOLDIER DIES AT ATTERBURY

Private Runcinski Is Found Unconscious at Camp Entrance.

Pvt. John S. Runcinski, 43, of Company D, 338th Engineers regiment at Camp Atterbury, died early Sunday morning at the camp after being found unconscious at the Edinburg entrance to the reservation.

An autopsy showed the soldier died of natural causes.

Officials of the camp are making an investigation of the circumstances surrounding the death.

Private Runcinski's home was in Cleveland, Ohio.

State police were called into the Runcinski case early Sunday morning.

According to the information given police, Runcinski had been put out of an automobile bearing Kentucky license plates at the camp entrance. Four civilians were reported in the car.

The state police were asked to be on the look-out for the Kentucky car.
