

XMAS PRIZES ARE AWARDED

Co. M, 331st Infantry, Wins Day Room Decoration Contest at Camp.

The winning day room was decorated with Christmas streamers hanging from the ceiling and gathered in the middle of the room, where a large Christmas bell was hung. The room also contained a decorated Christmas tree and posters, including a large one showing Santa Claus riding in a peep.
