

80 NET TEAMS AT ATTERBURY

Play Started in 10 Leagues
Representing Units from
Entire Camp.

Camp Atterbury, Ind., Jan. 2. (Special)—Basketball season is in full swing here with 80 teams playing in 10 leagues representing units of the entire camp. The net sport combines recreation with the physical fitness program in which all servicemen participate.

All league games are played in the large sports arena which has a playing floor space of 17,360 square feet. Rotating schedules call for play every night, with three full-size courts in use at the same time. Center swing-down baskets provide for a central court that is used for exhibition games by the camp varsity squad. Two thousand five hundred spectators can be accommodated at these games.

All recreational activities, including athletics, are under the supervision of Captain LeRoy L. Wahle, camp special services officer. Captain Harold W. Brown is special services officer for the 83rd Division. Lt. Don Veller, former basketball and football star at Indiana university and basketball coach at Elkhart high school, is post athletic officer.

Other officers assisting in the camp athletic program are Lt. Ralph Waldo, 83rd Division; Lt. Don Anderson, 365th Combat Team; Lt. Robert Zimmerman, Special Troops, 2nd Army; and Sgt. Harry Hudes, 72nd General Hospital. Sergeant Jerry Steiner, former All-American net star at Butler university in Indianapolis, assists Lt. Veller at the sports arena.
